



Mencap conditions of entry for ABP Newport Wales Marathon 2018

- 1) These terms and conditions apply to your place in the ABP Newport Marathon, 2018.
- 2) Participants must be 18 years of age or older on the day of the event.
- 3) Participants must be fit to run and free from injury
- 4) Participants enter the ABP Newport Wales Marathon at their own risk and Mencap shall not be liable for any injury or loss suffered or incurred as a result of participation in the event.
- 5) Participants must abide by the rules, instructions and regulations provided by the event organisers, Run 4 Wales, contracted agencies and officials.
- 6) Participants must only enter the race if they recognise that they make their best efforts in training for and completing the 26.2 mile course in less than 6 hours 30 minutes (around 15 minutes per mile which is a slow walking pace), calculated from the last runner to cross the start line. This is because roads across the city will need to re-open after this time. For your safety, if you are unable to keep to this pace you will be asked to board the sweep van collecting runners who are injured or unable to achieve the required pace at each mile.
- 7) For participants who choose not to board the sweep van when asked, Run 4 Wales will no longer accept liability for your welfare. At this point you will no longer be part of the race.
- 8) By taking part, all participants confirm that their names and/or video footage or photographs taken during their participation may be used to publicise the ABP Newport Wales Marathon and by Mencap.
- 9) Participants must not be under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- 10) Participant failure to collect his/her race pack, (if arranged with Run 4 Wales) on time will result in the forfeit of participation of the race. Under no exceptions can a participant collect their race pack after the designated time slots.

11) To receive a place in the ABP Newport Wales Marathon, participants must pay Mencap a non-refundable registration fee of £30.

12) Participants also agree to raise £300 in sponsorship.

13) The registration fee is only refundable if the event is cancelled by Mencap or Run 4 Wales.

14) If participants withdraw from the event, they must notify Mencap on 020 7696 6949 or email community.fundraising@mencap.org.uk

15) If for any reason the participant chooses not to take part or the event is cancelled, all sponsorship forms and money collected must be forwarded to Mencap and will not be refunded without a written request from individual sponsors

16) Participants must pass onto Mencap all monies raised in connection with the event. Participants can pay using the following methods:

- a) Pay online with your debit or credit card
- b) Raise funds through JustGiving or VirginMoneyGiving
- c) Send cheques payable to Mencap and posted to Community Fundraising, 123 Golden Lane, London, EC1Y 0RT.

17) By taking part in the event, participants confirm that they are happy for name, footage or photographs taken during your participation in ABP Newport Wales Marathon 2018 to be used to publicise Mencap's work. Any photographs or video footage may be used on Mencap's website and social media networks.

18) In fundraising for Mencap, participants agree the following:

- a. To submit all used and unused sponsorship forms
- b. Not to reproduce Mencap's logo without permission
- c. Not to collect in a private place without first obtaining a collectors license from the local authority
- d. Not to raise funds by carrying out house to house collections
- e. Not to raise funds by conducting a public lottery or raffle
- f. Not to do anything to bring the name of Mencap into disrepute.

19) It is up to participants to read the full terms and conditions set out by the race organiser Run 4 Wales, prior to the event.
